## 2025 Tanabe Young Investigator Award

### Daniel Gonzalez, PharmD, PhD

Associate Professor, Div of Clinical Pharmacology, Dept of Medicine,  
Duke Univ School of Medicine

Dr. Daniel Gonzalez is an Associate Professor in the Div of Clinical Pharmacology of the Dept of Medicine at the Duke Univ School of Medicine, and a member of the Duke Clinical Research Inst. Dr. Gonzalez received his PharmD and PhD from the Univ of Florida Coll of Pharmacy in 2008 and 2012, respectively. He then completed a postdoctoral fellowship through the Univ of North Carolina (UNC)-Duke Collaborative Clinical Pharmacology T32 Postdoctoral Training Program.

Dr. Gonzalez's experiences have afforded a highly collaborative and multidisciplinary research program focused on advancing public health by promoting the safe, effective and individualized use of drugs, with an emphasis on pediatric populations. His research program is funded by the Eunice Kennedy Shriver National Inst of Child Health and Human Development, and he has published >115 peer-reviewed publications and >40 abstracts. He has been the major advisor for eight PhD students (five completed, three in training) and 15 postdoctoral fellows.
