2024 Hartmut Derendorf Mentorship in Clinical Pharmacology Award

David J. Greenblatt, MD

Louis Lasagna Endowed Professor,
Tufts Univ School of Medicine

A native of Newton, Massachusetts, Dr. Greenblatt is a Magna Cum Laude graduate of Amherst Coll (1966). He graduated from Harvard Medical School in 1970, then trained in internal medicine at the Montefiore Hosp, New York City (1970-1971), and on the Harvard Medical Service at Boston City Hosp (1971-1972). Following a Fellowship in Clinical Pharmacology at Massachusetts General Hosp, under the mentorship of Dr. Jan Koch-Weser (1972-1974), he stayed on to head their Clinical Pharmacology Unit (1975-1979).

Dr. Greenblatt has been on the Faculty of Tufts Univ School of Medicine (TUSM) and the Staff of Tufts Medical Ctr (TMC) since 1979. He is a senior faculty member in the Graduate Program in Pharmacology & Drug Development and has previously served as Chair of the Dept of Pharmacology & Experimental Therapeutics at TUSM, Program Director and Associate Program Director of the institution's Clinical/Translational Research Ctr and Chair of the Institutional Review Board. He has served as postdoctoral training supervisor or dissertation supervisor for more than 60 trainees, most of whom have gone on to positions as university-based investigators or scientists in industry.
