The [2024 Annual Meeting of the American College of Clinical Pharmacology](#)® was a great success! ACCP is excited to report that this meeting was the **largest** in its 50+ year history.



A global audience heard presentations from 99 Faculty Speakers who participated in a Pre-meeting Workshop, Trends in Drug Development Seminar, the Plenary Session and 17 Symposia on a series of topics ranging from research and drug development to patient care. The Invited Keynote Jack Yanovski, MD, PhD gave an engaging presentation on "How Precise Is Current Pharmacotherapy for Pediatric & Adolescent Obesity?" Additionally, 167 scientific Posters were presented by authors from around the world. In follow up to the meeting, ACCP hosted the Clinical Pharmacology Review Course in collaboration with The American Board of Clinical Pharmacology.
